


Steps to request BADA Licence Agreement and obtain access to the BADA web applications:

In order to request a BADA Licence and obtain access to the BADA web applications you must first be a registered user of the EUROCONTROL OneSky Online. OneSky Online is the EUROCONTROL's Extranet where content can be accessed by authorised users only.

1) Connect here <https://ext.eurocontrol.int/> to register to OneSky Online.

If you don't already have a EUROCONTROL Account, create one by clicking on "New user? Register now". You will be notified by e-mail once your account will be created (this may take a few minutes).

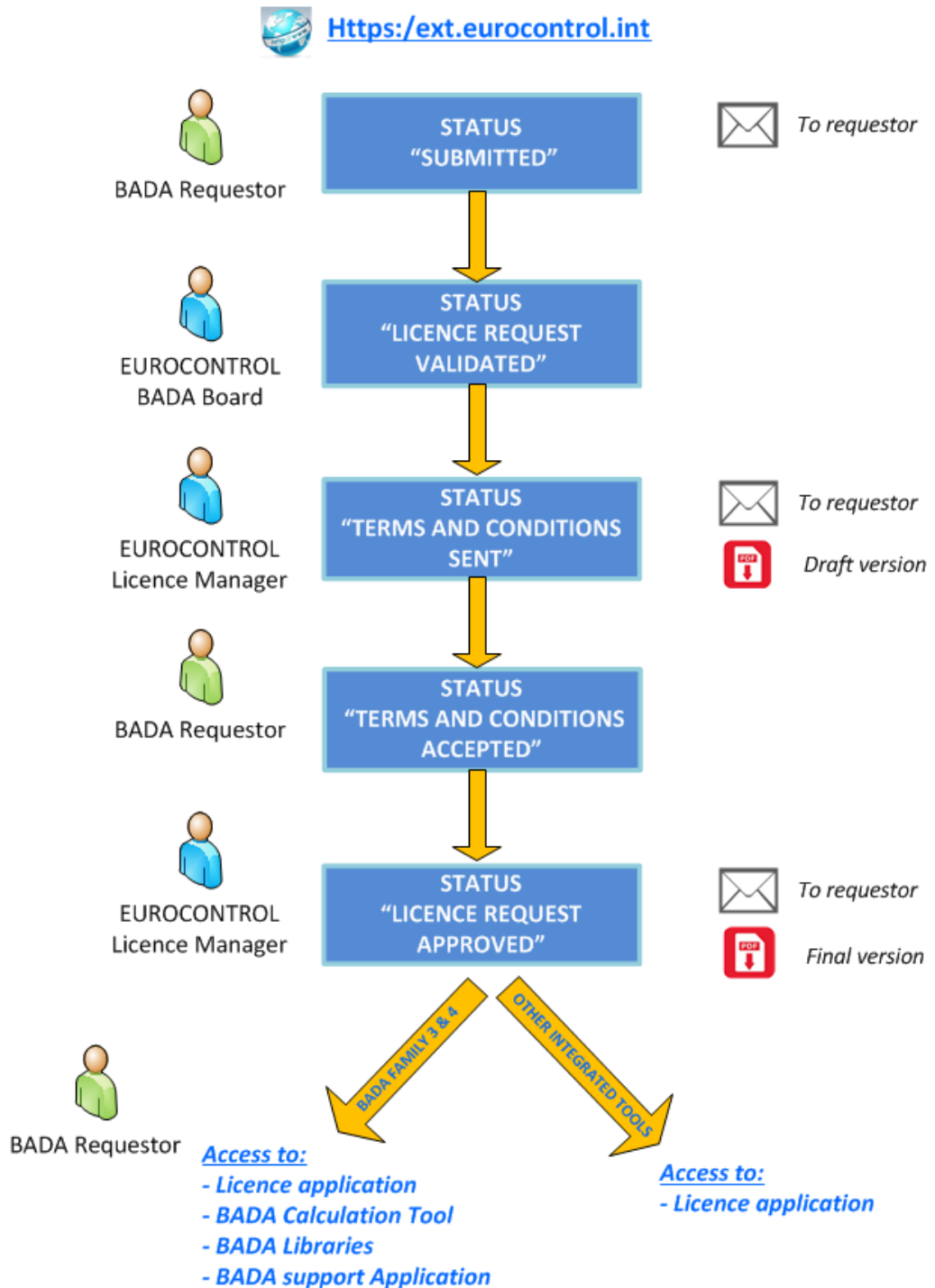
Licence Request Validation Workflow

Three possible cases:

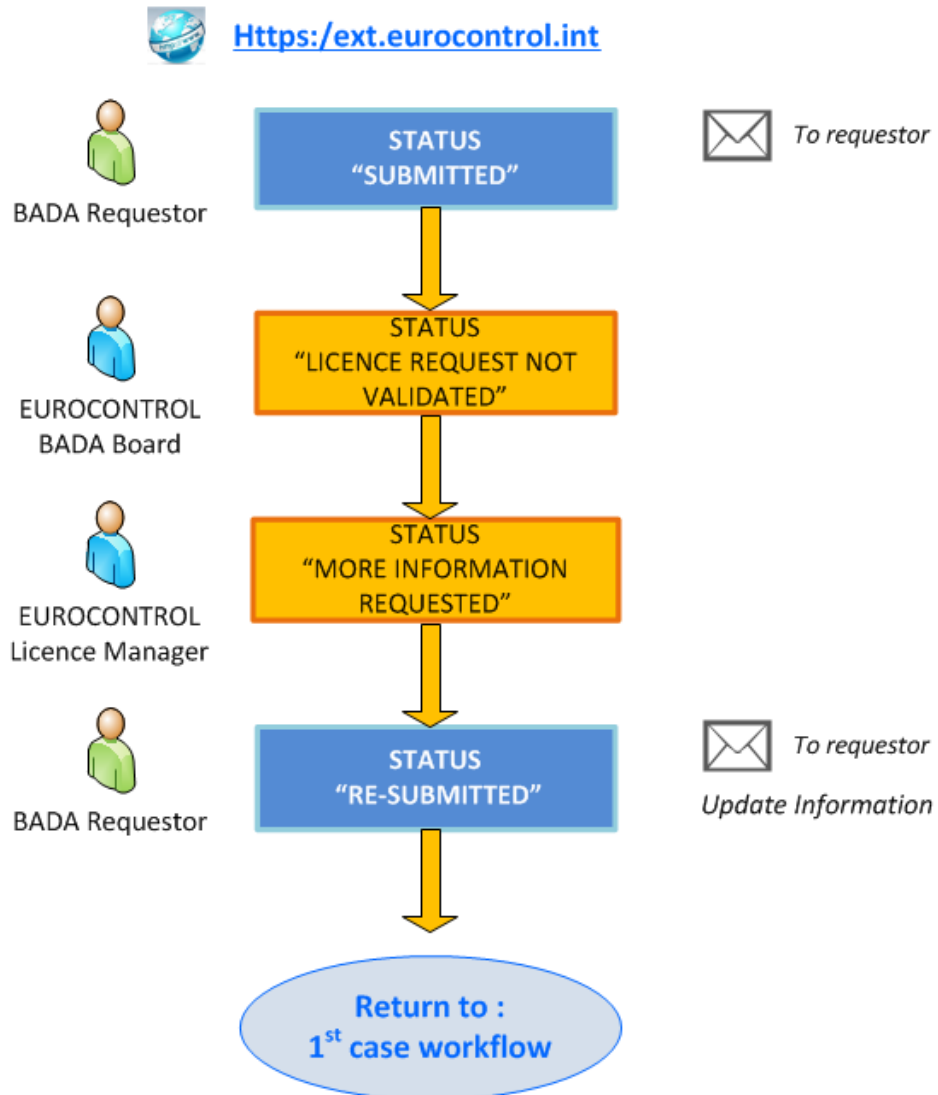
1. Request information complete, Licence approved by EUROCONTROL
 - a. All the relevant details about intended use are clearly provided
 - b. Legal authority information provided
 - c. Intended use in line with the permitted use of BADA
2. Request information lacks details
 - a. More information on intended use or legal authority is required
 - b. Another iteration for information completion is required to all EUROCONTROL Board to examine request
3. Licence request refused by EUROCONTROL
 - a. Intended use not in-line with BADA permitted use

LICENCE VALIDATION WORKFLOW

1. First case: Licence request information complete



2. Second case: Licence request information lacks details



3. Third case: Licence request refused by EUROCONTROL
